The ASDAN Personal Development Programme was implemented to provide Lucy with purpose and structure to her week with stimulating functional activities, as well as gaining relevant accreditation.

Lucy is heavily involved in sporting activities, particularly swimming. This has provided opportunities to use her achievements within her swimming club to gain accreditation in her ASDAN, alongside functional tasks in the community, life skills and specific learning tasks.

With lots of support and practice Lucy can now do this task confidently and independently, boosting her self-esteem and self-worth. This year Lucy has achieved both her Bronze and Silver award which is a huge achievement in one year.

Even though Lucy is going to a mainstream college, she enjoyed the ASDAN programme so much she has requested that she continues on to work towards her Gold award. She is also looking at completing a Sport and Fitness ASDAN Short Course as well as attending college.
